The objective of the three-year PhD program in Genetics, Molecular and Cellular Biology is the formation of leading scientists capable not only to perform, but also to plan, coordinate and evaluate basic and applied research activities in the fields of biology, biotechnology, biomedicine, food production and environmental assessment. Teaching is in English.

The PhD Program involves 52 faculty members from four departments of the University of Pavia (Biology and Biotechnology; Clinical-Surgical, Diagnostic and Pediatric Sciences; Molecular Medicine; Public Health, Forensic and Experimental Medicine) and the Institute of Molecular Genetics of the National Research Council (IGM-CNR).

SCHOLARSHIPS: 9 (funded by the University of Pavia).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: an academic degree awarded in Italy or abroad and recognised in advance as being eligible for the PhD Program. The degree from abroad must be comparable to an Italian university second-level degree in terms of duration, level and disciplinary field.
