Prof. Olivieri published a total of 65 articles in international ISI journals (two additional papers are under review at the moment) and a book chapter. Four papers are last authored (corresponding author or senior author) (Raveane et al., 2019; Battaglia et al. 2016; Gandini et al. 2016 and de Saint Pierre et al. 2012). Six papers are first authored (Olivieri et al. 2017; 2016; 2013; 2006; and Achilli, Olivieri et al. 2011 and Achilli, Olivieri et al. 2008 with equal contribution).
